### **TRUE AMBITION**

Again, the scriptures bring us to the problem of bad ambition, in the persons of the Apostles St. John and St. James. What is it? It's a dysfunctional desire for power and honour. What is good ambition? It is magnanimity: a desire to do great things for God and/or for others. Einstein was magnanimous. The saints are all magnanimous, even St. Therese of the Little Flower. The bad ambition is to want to do great things for the aggrandizement of my ego. "I don't want so much to do great things but I want to get others to see me doing great things." (Bishop Barron) St. John and St. James – they were not saints yet because it's before Pentecost – want to have honour and power for their own ego. They don't seek at this point in their lives to do great things for others and for God with this power and honour that they request from Jesus. They want to be seen at the right and left of the triumphant Messiah.

True ambition may seek power and honour, but not for themselves, rather in order to do good things for others more effectively. St. Dominic prayed regularly for the grace of an effective charity! Some power is needed for that, some spiritual and even material power. Immature people who receive honour and power too early, like Justin Beiber, can become manipulative, abusive, cruel, oppressive, overbearing. The saints, when they have power and credentials like Mother Teresa, want to do more for God and for others. Their hearts open up to a universal love, an efficacious love. That is true ambition! Padre Pio, one of the most humble saints, did great things. He built a big hospital in his poor village, a hospital equipped with the latest technology: and he started an international prayer group movement to have people all over the world pray for the sick in this hospital and for the doctors, nurses and staff. Many, many miracles happened as a result.

Bad ambition: a mother (or a father) may want her son or daughter to do great things in life because she wants to be honoured for that, she wants through her children the honour she didn't get! Good ambition: a mother or a father want their children to do great things so that these might have the joy of bearing good fruits for others and give glory to God. Good ambition, magnanimity, make you bend low to serve others. Dr. Lloyd Judd practiced medicine in rural Oklahoma. Many of his patients were poor, and had no transportation. So he often had to drive to their homes to treat them. In his last letter to his children, he wrote "Are you willing to get out of a warm bed on a cold night and drive 20 miles (35km) to see a sick person, knowing that they could wait until morning to be treated? If you can say yes to that question, you are ready to study medicine." (quoted by Fr. Mark Link, S.J.) At the end of your life, you will not be judged according to how much fame, money, prestige and power you accumulated, but on how you used them. Was it for the service of others, and for the love of God?

How do you get free from the desire of vain glory and power? By doing the opposite! By seeking to be like a little child! By doing everything to serve God and His people. Then you will be the freest person on earth.
